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The Timelist Project — Feature Documentary Announced with Relevé Entertainment and Merge TV

Lancaster, CA — Timelist Group, Inc., the 501(c)(3) reentry nonprofit founded by Yusef Andre Wiley, today announced “The Timelist Project,” an in-development feature documentary produced with Relevé Entertainment (Dr. Holly Carter) and Merge TV.

Yusef Andre Wiley founded Timelist Group, Inc. in 2007 as a peer-led initiative inside CDCR. Today he leads a portfolio that includes 9 LA County housing sites carrying a \$63,000-per-month utility burden, the CalAIM Justice-Involved service line, and a transitional-workforce model built around the people it serves. He is the author of *If I Knew Then and What I Know Now*.

In 2026 the organization crossed \$10M in annual operating budget and 100 team members, scaling housing capacity from 86 to 171+ reentry beds across LA County — including new women’s sites — and launching Transpire 2.0, ChiefDesk, and RoamSmart as adjacent ventures that deepen the reentry infrastructure.

The Timelist Project, an in-development feature documentary produced with Dr. Holly Carter of Relevé Entertainment and partners Timelist Group, Relevé Entertainment, and Merge TV, follows Wiley’s four-act arc — The Beginning, The Turning Point, The Building, The Legacy — and frames the documentary’s posture less as a campaign story than as a working answer to one civic question: what does durable second-chance infrastructure look like.

“This film exists to make the operating reality visible,” said Yusef Andre Wiley, Founder & Executive Director, Timelist Group, Inc. “We are not lobbying for second chances — we are building the infrastructure that makes them durable, and the documentary is the working record of what that looks like in practice.”
